October...

The month everyone thinks of when they think of fall.

The season of Halloween.

A time when ghosts and goblins and things that go bump in the night are celebrated.

And traditionally it is also a time when the bad guys take center stage.

I remember once upon a time when the local TV station did a Halloween Marathon and it featured some of the most notorious characters in history. There was Dracula, Frankenstein's Monster, The Bride of Frankenstein, The Wolfman, and Lizzy Bordon.

I know the last one seemed a little strange, but it actually fit in given how the movie itself was somewhat scary and, even though she was never convicted of it, she was allegedly a notoriously brutal double-murderer. Plus the movie showed a rather salacious theory of how Lizzy supposedly carried out her crime, so between the hinted nudity and the blood, it did fit in with the general theme of the night.

The dirty little secret about stories featuring heroes is that quite often the villains are the ones that have the better histories.

Heroes quite often are boring. We already know who they are and why they do what they do. It's the villains that lead the more interesting lives. Or they have the more twisted lives. We want to know why they do what they do. What is their story?

The villains are the ones that take the action that the heroes have to respond to. They're the ones causing the disasters. The devastation is being done in their name and for their purposes.

So How Did We Get Here?

The Libra Order first appeared in "Guardians of the Dawn Spotlight" #17 as a different way to show life in the Rogue Isles. Readers were already given a taste of the Rogue Isles in the two-part "Limelight" storyline as Midnight Arachnia tried to survive while in hiding. But with the Order, we exposed something you normally would not see in the "City of Villains"; namely the infrastructure that keeps the Rogue Isles going regardless of who "rules" it.

In order to show this, we needed operatives that were not really evil... or not really in league with Lord Recluse and Arachnos. Operatives that wouldn't object too loudly to working with heroes.

Some of the operatives were a perfect fit for the Guardians, like Isea and Lyon Powers. Some, like Tyrannus 4 and MidKnight X, required a little fudging. And then, of course, there was Omega Shift. Being a shapshifter has its advantages.

Then there needed to be a "control operative", someone within the Order that knew enough about the infrastructure to cause damage. Who better than a real "rogue" operative with rumors of a special "family lineage"?

It was after this one-issue look at the Order that the idea came about for "payback". After all, the operation did not go off as "flawlessly" as was hoped. Mistakes were made. People were hurt.

The idea was that there would be a multi-part storyline called "Debts of Honor" which would feature one member of the Order getting payback against the Guardian that impersonated them. The very first one would be Misty Mysery, and you could actually see that in "Spotlight" #27.

Sadly, the storyline could not be developed as I was forced to shelve my access to "The City" for a few months. When I was able to return with "The Guardian Powers", I had hoped to bring that storyline back. Again, you saw references to that in "The Guardian Powers" #8 with Libra releasing John Cole from the Isles and telling Tainted Eve to "Gather my forces".

But, once again, that was not meant to be as NCSoft began to sunset the MMO. Not all storylines could be cleared up before the shutdown, so "Debts of Honor" was one of many un-realized ideas.

Then came the "gift"... a way for me to resume telling stories thanks to Titan Icon and demorecording. A way for me to return to "The City" and bring you the stories you loved for so long.

My "return" came in a three-part miniseries called "Guardians of the Dawn GRADUATION", which originally was supposed to be a one-shot issue, but there was just too much story to keep in a single issue. "Debts of Honor" was supposed to be included as part of the story, but there just was not enough room to include it and the other storylines. Plus it just didn't seem to fit with the overall storyline in "GRADUATION".

On top of it all, there were some events in "GRADUATION" that I'm sure people thought were strange. Certain pieces were missing... "Debts of Honor" would fill those in.

So the decision was made to give the Libra Order their own one-shot special... and the timing could not be better.

Where Do We Go From Here?

Well the answer to that is simple... onward with the next phase.

The Widowmaker is back. But how will he affect the man who once was him? Who are the other "exiles" that Mistress Libra mentioned to Nox? And what can be done to stop Nox before his boss decides to show up to "collect" the "Guardian Exiles"?

All of these and more will be answered in January of 2015 as we launch...

We strive to one day see a Fortunata without her helmet.


